

Important to Know!

Place containers within 5 feet of the public street by 6:00am on your pick-up day. Please do not block public streets, sidewalks, driveways, mailboxes, or on-street parking.

Extra recyclables may be placed in sturdy paper bags or cardboard boxes marked "recycling" and placed next to your recycling cart on collection day (box size limit: 3' x 3').

Holiday Schedule: Your recycling will be collected on the same holiday schedule as your garbage.

Inclement Weather: When collection cannot be safely provided due to inclement weather or other dangerous conditions, any missed recycling will be collected on your next scheduled recycle day.

Expanded Commingled Recycling

Now recycle more materials than ever!

With the **Allied Waste** Expanded Commingled Recycling Program, now you can recycle even more materials in your recycling container(s)! Expanded Commingled Recycling is easy and reduces the amount of garbage you put out for collection -- which may help reduce your garbage costs!

Items you may recycle include plastics 1-5, and 7, round dairy tubs, polycoated beverage containers (juice, soy milk boxes), clean metal (size limit: 24" x 24" x 12"). All materials, even glass bottles and jars, can now be combined together in your recycling cart. No need to separate glass from your other recyclables.

Why Expanded Commingled Recycling?

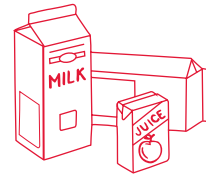
These improvements in recycling come from new technologies at our processing facility in Seattle. Research shows participation and recycling levels increase when sorting is not required. Expanded Commingled Recycling is more efficient because collection trucks can hold more materials in a single load.

Recyclable Materials

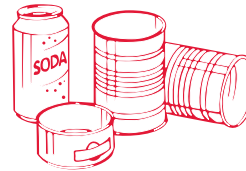
Remember to remove all food residue. Put all clean recyclables loose in your cart, including:

- Clean Paper and Mail
- Newspaper and Advertising
- Phonebooks
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Flattened Cardboard (3' x 3' max)
- Paper food boxes (liner removed)
- Frozen food boxes
- Milk cartons and Juice boxes



- Plastic Bottles and Jugs (no lids or caps)
- Round Dairy tubs (no lids)

- Aluminum Cans
- Tin or Steel Cans

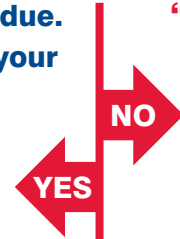


- Clean Metal (24" x 24" x 12", 35 lb. max)
- Glass Bottles and Jars (no lids)

NON-Recyclable Materials

"When in doubt, throw it out!"

- NO Food 
- NO Garbage 
- NO Food Soiled Paper or Boxes
- NO Styrofoam Containers/Pellets
- NO Plastic Take-out Containers
- NO Plastic Trays (bakery, meat, etc)
- NO Paper Plates or Napkins
- NO Plastic Cups and Utensils 
- NO Car Parts
- NO Light Bulbs 
- NO Toxic Containers (antifreeze, oil, etc)
- NO Tin or Aluminum foil
- NO Disposable Diapers or Rags
- NO Lids or Caps 
- NO Syringes 
- NO Window Glass or Mirrors 
- NO Ceramics, Dishes, Glassware
- NO Plastic bags 
- NO Plastic #6 



Please put extra recyclables in paper bags or cardboard boxes marked "recycling."
No plastic bags please. There is no charge for extra recyclables.
