Terms & Conditions

- Delivery:** City of Anacortes agrees to deliver a container to the job site stated above, retrieve the container, and recycle the materials deposited in the container at a permitted recycling facility.
- Payment:** This contract, asbestos or lead testing and payment of the delivery fee **are required before the drop box can be delivered.** The delivery fee includes setup, removal, and applicable fees. The daily fee starts on the 8th day of service. Daily fees, haul fees, and tonnage fees are billed to the property utility account. Please call (360) 293-1921 for hauls and removal. Solid Waste requires a three-day lead-time for drop box service including delivery, hauls and removal.
- Inspection Report:** Asbestos & lead paint inspection must be provided to receive recycling rates listed on back. If inspection report is not provided to the City of Anacortes, then garbage rates apply to loads.
- Damage to Container:** The customer is responsible for any and all damage to the container incurred while it is in the Customer's possession.
- Indemnity:** The Customer agrees to defend, indemnify and hold City of Anacortes harmless from any and all claims, demands, losses and liabilities to or by third parties relating to bodily injury or property damage involving the container at the job site.
- Contaminated Loads:** City of Anacortes accepts only materials that may be recycled. See reverse side for the Acceptable Materials List dated Jan 2017.
- Garbage Receptacle:** All job sites, by law, are required to have a garbage receptacle. This is the responsibility of the Customer. The Customer or a garbage service provider can do hauling of this receptacle.
- Assignment:** This contract may not be assigned to any other person or company without the express written and signed consent of the other party. This prohibition of assignment applies not only to the assignment of rights to compel performance but also to the assignment of any claim or cause of action, including but not limited to claims for breach of contract, tort and indemnification.

Container Rules

- Containers must be accessible to the collection vehicle and placed on approved level surface with unobstructed access.
- Containers must be loaded evenly; not be overloaded; only fill to fill line.
- Containers must dump by gravity; Solid Waste crew personnel will not remove waste.
- Containers may only be filled halfway with solid asphalt roofing material due to weight restrictions.
- Styrofoam, sawdust, & loose materials must be bagged & tied securely closed.
- Weight of drop box and collection trucks may cause damage to surfaces.
