

## **Washington Park Boat Launch and Parking Lot Policies**

The boat launch at Washington Park is developed and maintained for the specific use of recreational boaters. Boat owners may drive down and backup on the boat launching ramp for the purpose of releasing or collecting their boat. Boaters may not leave their trailer and towing vehicle on the launching ramp or surrounding area after they have launched their boat (the maximum stay is 15 minutes). Towing vehicle and trailers must be parked in the designated lot, parked correctly, free from traffic and congestion or they are subject to impoundment.

The boat launching / trailer parking lot at Washington Park is not to be used for commercial purposes unless permitted by the Parks Director.

The boat trailer parking lot is to be used only for vehicle and trailer parking. No single vehicles may park in this lot. All vehicles and attached trailers must be parked between designated lines, and parking is limited to a 14 day stay per visit. Annual pass holders may stay longer, with the permission of the Park Manager. Any misuse of parking regulations may subject vehicle to impoundment and/or a penalty issued by the Anacortes Police Department.

Camping in boats or R.V.s with boats attached will be allowed by permission from the Park Manager for one night only at a charge of \$9.00 in addition to the regular parking fee. Open fires are not allowed in this area. The intent of this policy is to allow boaters arriving late to the park and leaving early for a trip a place to stay.
