This agreement when signed by the customer and approved by the City will authorize temporary container service according to the following regulations and rate schedule.

Two business days notice is required to provide on time container delivery. Containers may be delivered earlier, however the rental will not commence until the requested start date. Daily fees accrue each day the container is on the customer's property or until notice is received by the City to terminate the service. Customer will not be charged for the day the container is delivered or service is terminated.

The City must receive customer requests for container dumping one working day in advance of the requested service date. (Monday through Friday, excluding holidays)

Regulations for Commercial and Temporary Containers (QUESTIONS: CALL 293-1921):

- No material with asbestos content.
- No large car parts or heavy metal objects except for small toys, food containers, etc.
- No furniture or appliances - call 293-1921 for a special haul.
- No rocks, blocks of concrete or metal pipe.
- No medical waste.
- No batteries, hazardous waste, paint, or toxic materials.
- No animal waste or carcasses.
- No yard waste including sod, brush, etc.
- No materials containing excessive amounts of water.
- Ask about special arrangements for roofing materials.

Load evenly; do not overload; only fill to the rim or designated fill line.

Containers must be placed on approved surface with unobstructed access 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM weekdays. Please bag up Styrofoam, sawdust, and any other loose materials before placing in container. Bags must be securely tied closed.

Containers must dump by gravity; Sanitation personnel will not remove waste.

A fee may be charged to return to a customer's premises to dump a container not accessible to the collection vehicle or overloaded on the scheduled day in accordance with Ordinance #2374.
