- Tonnage fees (\$97 a ton), extra haul fees (\$206.38 per haul), any daily fees (\$18.76 per day) after the 7 days, and all applicable taxes

The amounts that are not covered will be billed to the utility account at that location or sent to the above billing address provided by person(s) requesting the drop box

Terms & Conditions:

1. **Delivery:** City of Anacortes agrees to deliver a drop box to the job site stated above, retrieve the drop box, and dispose of the materials.
2. **Payment:** This contract and payment of the delivery fee **are required before the drop box can be delivered**. The delivery fee includes setup, removal, and applicable fees. The daily fee starts on the 8th day of service. Daily fees, haul fees, and tonnage fees are billed to the property utility account. Please call (360) 293-1921 for hauls and removal. Solid Waste requires a three-day lead-time for drop box service including delivery, hauls and removal.
3. **Damage to Drop Box:** The customer is responsible for any and all damage to the container incurred while it is in the Customer's possession.
4. **Indemnity:** The Customer agrees to defend, indemnify and hold City of Anacortes harmless from any and all claims, demands, losses and liabilities to or by third parties relating to bodily injury or property damage involving the container at the job site.
5. **Uninspected Loads:** City of Anacortes will accept only uninspected loads at the garbage rate. Please call the Solid Waste Department at (360) 293-1921 for the Acceptable Materials List.
6. **Garbage Receptacle:** All job sites, by law, are required to have a garbage receptacle. This is the responsibility of the Customer. The Customer or a garbage service provider can do hauling of this receptacle.
