Proposal Description

This legislative proposal would amend the Comprehensive Plan's Capital Facilities Plan Element with the updated inventory, 20-year needs analysis, and six-year financing plan. The proposal is available at the website above.

SEPA Threshold Determination

The City of Anacortes has determined that this proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement is not required under the State Environmental Policy Act, RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This determination was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency and available upon request.

This determination is issued pursuant to WAC 197-11-340(2). The City of Anacortes will not act on this proposal for 14 calendar days from the date of issuance. The SEPA comment and appeal period runs from November 18, 2020 to December 3, 2020 at 5:00 PM.

Comments are accepted via email, paper, or verbally. All written comments must be received by the deadline and include (1) your full name, (2) your mailing address, and (3) the proposal name (“2021-2026 Capital Facilities Plan Update”). Comments that do not meet these requirements will not be considered.
