The following amendment is proposed for the City of Anacortes’s 2020 Annual Action Plan. This amendment is made in order to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. This Amendment is made in accordance with the City’s Citizen Participation Plan of the Community Development Block Grant and includes additional funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce CDBG-CV funding.

Introduction

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and additional funding allocations to combat this pandemic, the 2020 Annual Action Plan is being amended to include a project to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus.

PROPOSED CHANGES:

1. 2020 Annual Action Plan. In order to prepare, respond to and prevent the coronavirus, the city has received CDBG-CV (coronavirus) funding from HUD and is eligible for HUD CV funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce.
2. The City will utilize \$42,232 in CDBG-CV funding and \$24,968 from the State of Washington Commerce Department CV funding to assist elderly and disabled individuals with assistance in response to the Covid pandemic. Assistance will include home visits with elderly and disabled individuals to provide Covid vaccines for those unable to obtain vaccines away from their homes and assistance to lower income patients recovering from the effects of the Covid-19 virus and are unable to readily access outpatient care during recovery.

This funding cannot be used to duplicate funding provided by other sources.

SUMMARY OF CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PROCESS AND CONSULTATION PROCESS:

These amendments are a result of consultation with stakeholders and public agencies providing services in the City. The Notice of Plan Amendment was published in accordance with the expedited regulations to address the COVID -19 pandemic in the Anacortes American on May 26, 2021 and posted on the City's website on May 21, 2021.
