



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
AMENDMENT OF 2022 CDBG ACTION PLAN**

The Consolidated Plan is the planning and application requirements for the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), a program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Consolidated Plan includes yearly Action Plans that describe how CDBG funds will be used to help the City meet the community development needs. A revision to the 2022 Action Plan is being initiated to include an additional project.

The City will allocate \$35,081.17 in previous CDBG-CV funding to public services to prevent, prepare for and respond to coronavirus. The 2022 Annual Action Plan will be amended to include the distribution of the funding which will be available immediately after the 5 day public review period. HUD allows a 5 day minimum public comment period in light of the public emergency caused by the COVID-19 outbreak.

The 5 day comment period for the Amendment is December 14, 2022 through December 20, 2022 (5 business days). The Amendment will be available for review and comment during this time. If you would like to provide written comments on the amendment, please send written comments to Joann Stewart at joanns@cityofanacortes.org between December 14 and December 20, 2022.
